

Overview

Most questionnaires were developed in English speaking countries. With the increase in the number of multinational and multicultural research project, the need to use and to adapt questionnaires has grown rapidly.

The cross – cultural adaptation of health status self-administered questionnaire for use in new country, country and/or language necessitates use of a unique method, to reach equivalence between the original source and target versions of the questionnaire.

The items must not only translate well linguistically but should also be adapted culturally to maintain the content validity of the instrument at a conceptual level across different cultures.

However, the dilemma faced by the researchers in Malaysia for example in the field of child and adolescent psychiatry and paediatrics are the availability of validated questionnaires.

Without validated questionnaires conclusions from these researchers are questionable.

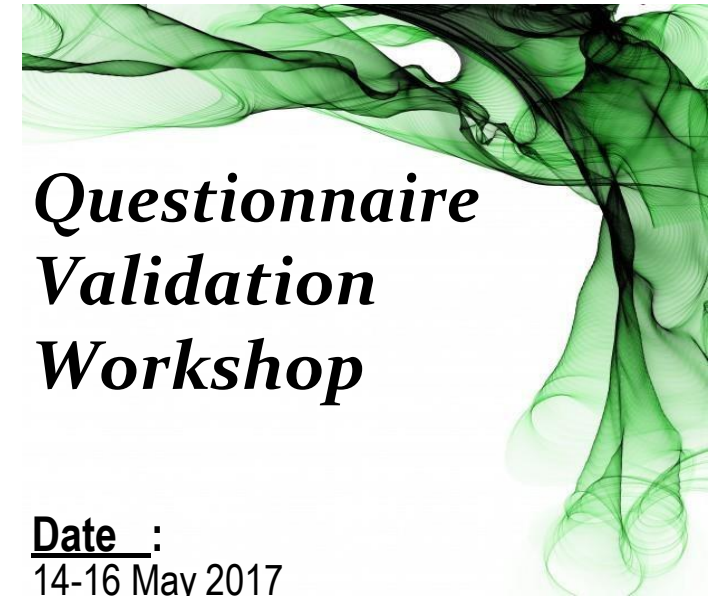
