

APPLICATION GUIDELINE FOR ELECTIVE POSTING (MEDICAL STUDENT)

Medical students who wish to apply for elective posting at Sarawak General Hospital, Kuching please take note of the following:

1. The total length of the posting should not exceed six (6) weeks. The minimum time spend in any particular discipline should not be less than three (3) weeks.
2. Applications should be submitted to the State Health Director for approval at least three (3) months before the proposed date prior to reporting at Sarawak General Hospital.
3. You will be subjected to the existing rules and regulations of the hospital. Attached herewith the Rules and Regulations as in **Appendix A**.
4. You will be posted to the department of your choice subject to vacancy. Priority will be given to the medical students who are already in clinical rotations in your respective universities.
5. If the above conditions are acceptable, you may submit the application form (**Appendix B**), letter from the Dean of your University and photocopy of MyKad (for Malaysian) or passport (for foreigners) to:
